

## **DISTRICT JUNIOR GOLF CHAIR / COMMITTEE**

**PURPOSE:** To promote and conduct a District Level Optimist Junior Golf qualifying event to represent the District annually at the Championships in July.

**PERSONNEL:** Committee members should be able to reach out to young people who are interested in golf. Contacting Golf coaches, academies, and schools are good ways to find players and generate interest in the event. The Committee can consist of as many members as are interested. An interest in golf is beneficial although it is not required.

### **DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- To promote the qualifier by seeking participants for the District Qualifying event.
- To organize the qualifier at a course or courses within your District boundaries. These responsibilities include securing a course, communicating with potential players, coordinating with Junior Golf Staff at Optimist International, purchase awards, course preparation, scoring, etc.
- To contact local businesses to solicit sponsorships. These sponsorships help offset the cost of the event to keep player registrations down. You should also look for ways to fund your budget to give more players financial help through local businesses and individuals. Clubs and club members can help in this area by working with local businesses in their area.

**ACTION PLANS:** As Committee Chair, urge clubs to participate with volunteers at the District event and help sponsor players that advance into the Championships in July.
